Facility Reservations

Reservations must be completed for picnic facilities, buildings, and athletic fields by completing the on-line reservation form. For your outdoor event, consider one of the Youth Bureau's picnic facilities:

YAMAN, SUGGETT, & BEAUDRY PARK FACILITIES:

- Can accommodate 100-150 people
- Equipped with tables, grills, chairs, and rest rooms
- Price: \$150 for city residents, \$175 for non-city residents
- *A security deposit of \$100 is required for Suggett & Beaudry

DEXTER PARK, BEAUDRY PARK, YAMAN PARK CABANAS:

• Smaller shelters. First come, first serve basis

CYB Policies

Late Fee Policy

Any registration after the start, the program will incur a \$10 late fee charge.

Refund Policy

Any refund requested before the program begins will be granted a full refund, minus a \$5 processing fee.

Any refund requested after the program begins will be granted half the program fee, minus a \$5 processing fee.

Security Deposit

A security deposit of \$100, cash or check only, is required for all facility key sign-outs. The only exception will be granted by the Director or Assistant Director and written on the key sign out form.

Facility Rentals

You may not enter the building (for set up, bringing items over, etc) until the day of your reservation.



YOUTH SPORTS & PROGRAMS



John Tobin Youth Basketball League

The program will be offered to boys and girls in grades 1st - 6th. Grades 1st and 2nd will have an instructional clinic, grades 3rd through 6th will include instructional skills and league games. Competition of league play will include games against surrounding communities. Registration for the basketball program is on RecDesk and will be held from September 15th through October 20th. The program fee is \$60 and will include a t-shirt or uniform. Practice sessions will begin in December and games will start in January 2026. Practices will be held at local elementary schools and games will be played at the Cortland YMCA, Parker School, and Cortland High School. The league is seeking knowledgeable basketball coaches and officials. Applications and background check forms are available at the CYB office.

Wrestling

Learn basic techniques and the fundamentals of wrestling! Our practice sessions will be held on Monday and Thursdays for grades K-6 (starting 1/5) at the Cortland High School wrestling room. Grades K-2 will practice 6:00-6:45 and grades 3-6 will practice 6:00-7:30pm. Matches with other local wrestling clubs will be scheduled, and wrestlers can participate in the end of the year League Tournament. Cost: \$35 city residents and \$45 non city residents. Practices will begin early January through mid-March, dates are TBA. Registration starts on-line November 1st through December 31st.



Fun For Tots Fall Session

Fun For Tots is a program for children 4 and under and their parents/caregivers to meet and interact with other children their age and other parents in the community. Children under the age of one are welcome to come with their siblings free of charge. The group meets Mondays and Wednesdays from 10:00am-11:30am and often meets the County Office Building Gym to play with a wide variety of toys supplied by the CYB. The group also does arts and crafts, meets at local parks, goes on field trips to different places in the community, and much more. The program begins Monday September 15th and will run through December. Cost: \$20 per child for city residents, \$25 per child for non-city residents. Registration will be open throughout the length of the program.

Greek Peak Ski & Snowboard Club

Skiers and snowboarders in grades 3-6 can join the after school ski club and enjoy Central New York's largest ski center. To register, go to greekpeak.snowcloud.shop. Select desired pass option from tabs. Enter skier information, complete waivers, and check out. Transportation is provided, but you must register on CYB website. No cost for bus. Grade: 3rd-6th. 

Rec. Center

Located in downtown Cortland at 35 Port Watson Street, the Youth Rec offers a huge variety of programs and events for young people: Field trips, game tournaments, tutoring, guest speakers, music lessons, artwork, craft projects, cooking classes, free dinners, job-search assistance, volunteer opportunities, and more. The facility itself is equipped with pool, ping-pong, and foosball tables; a full kitchen; a music room with guitars, amps, and a full drum-kit; a sound stage and DJ booth; and closets full of board games and craft supplies. There are always responsible, caring staff members on the premises to play games with you, help with your homework, or connect you with other service agencies if you need them. Volunteer Incentive Program

Kids who do community service or help with tasks at the Rec Center can earn discounts on the Center's field trip and program fees. For every hour a youth spends volunteering, the Center will take \$5.00 off the price of a field trip or program. Kids can use their service credits immediately or save them up for later use. Credits earned and used are recorded in a logbook. Rec Center staff can help place teens with businesses and agencies who need volunteers.

Rec Center Kitchen

If you like to cook (or if you just like to eat), then stop by the Rec Center on weeknights around suppertime. Two or three nights per week, we cook up a full dinner for all to enjoy. The meals are always free. Kids are welcome to help with the cooking under the supervision of staff. We also offer periodic cooking classes and theme nights, so keep your eye on the calendar. The Rec Center kitchen operates under strict Health Department guidelines and is regularly cleaned and inspected.
